### **Fundraising Convener: Vicki Kaniouris**



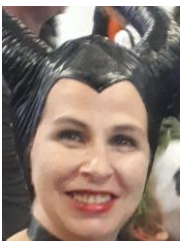
Kids: Jonathan 12 and Catherine 9.
