Thank you to all the students who have set up their online fundraising profile. All students should have received their fundraising booklet where they can note down any cash donations they get and can see what prizes they can choose. All students who raise \$10 or more will get to choose a prize.

If you have not already don't forget to place your orders via QKR! for the Coon Cheese Toasties (\$3 each) for lunch. Parents/grandparents are welcome to come for lunch and watch the event so order for everybody. Lunch will be a little earlier than usual from 12.30 – 1.15pm with the event to follow.

A few parents have had some questions about the event. Here is a few FAQ's which might assist:

1. **What does my child wear?** Children can wear mufti. White clothing (particularly a shirt) will work best to show up the colour. If you don't have white just wear a light colour. The colour is made up of corn starch and food grade dye.
2. **My child does not want to get wet or coloured, can they still participate?** Yes definitely. There will be inflatables for students to run under and a course marked out on the oval. There will be stations where students will get squirted with liquid color (from water guns) and other stations where there will be bubble machines and bubble wands. Students can choose to avoid these if they wish. There will also be a drink station with cups of cold water. All students will be issued sunglasses to keep and a Berry fruit ice block at the end.
3. **Can parents/grandparents come to watch?** Yes. The event will start at 1.15pm but why not come at 12.30 and have a cheese toastie with your child.
4. **Is there a minimum my child has to fundraise?** There is no minimum, however all children who raise \$10 or more will get to choose a prize from the list.
5. **My child is only fundraising in cash, do I need to set up an online profile as well?** Yes, if possible. Cash donations can be entered manually under the student's profile so it helps us track how our fundraising is going and also enables your child to pick their prize online.
